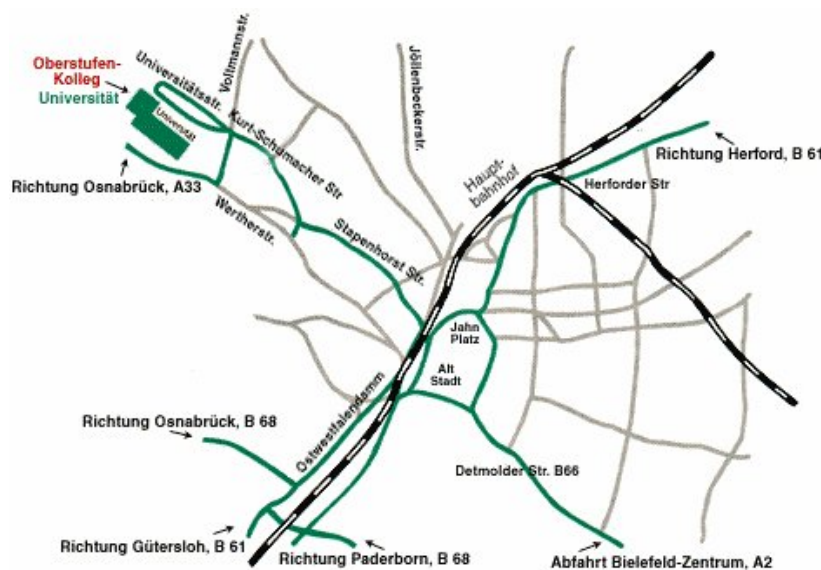

Anreise zur Universität



Anreise mit dem Auto:

Autobahn A2: Ausfahrt Bi-Zentrum, Detmolder Str. Richtung Zentrum (6 km, ca. 10 min). Weg über Kreuzstr., Oberntorwall, Stapenhorststr., Kurt-Schumacher-Str. (ist ausgeschildert).

Anreise mit der Bahn:

Bielefeld Hauptbahnhof. Aus dem Vorderausgang rausgehen, geradeaus weiter über den Zebrastreifen und dann nach 20 m links runter in den U-Bahnbereich.

Dann mit der Stadtbahnlinie 4 Richtung Universität/Lohmannshof. Bis zur Haltestelle Universität (Fahrzeit 7 Minuten).

Taxis sind stets direkt vor dem Hauptbahnhof verfügbar.

Der Fahrpreis bis zur Universität beträgt zur Zeit etwa Euro 8.-
