**Help us shape the new Medical School OWL at Bielefeld University: interprofessional, future-oriented, diverse and strong in research and teaching**

Bielefeld University stands for interdisciplinarity, high quality research and teaching, and the further development of a gender-equitable university culture. A wide variety of subjects, perspectives, and people work together in an interdisciplinary way to ensure innovative research and teaching at the highest level. The approximately 25,000 students have access to a differentiated range of subjects in the humanities, natural sciences, social sciences and technology. In addition to its international orientation, Bielefeld University is excellently networked in the city and region, which is characterized by medium-sized companies.

Bielefeld University is currently developing an innovative Faculty of Human Medicine with an interdisciplinary focus on individual and population medicine. Teaching is scheduled to begin in the winter semester 2021/22. You will be significantly involved in the differentiation of the model degree program of studies in human medicine according to ÄApprO (German medical licensing regulations). You will have the opportunity to apply innovative and sustainable concepts in medical education. Experience in the development and implementation of innovative teaching concepts is thus expressly desired.

A prerequisite for taking on the following professorships advertised below is active participation in the development of the medical research profile ([https://www.uni-bielefeld.de/\(de\)/medizin/forschung/index.html](https://www.uni-bielefeld.de/(de)/medizin/forschung/index.html)) of Bielefeld University "Medicine for People with Disabilities and Chronic Diseases". In particular, we would like to see an intensive willingness to engage in one of the currently planned research areas "Brain, Disability, Participation" and "Intelligent Systems, Assistance, Interprofessional Networking" and/or in one of the medical research areas to be developed "Microbial Diversity in the Human Habitat" and "Data Science for Medical Care". Future research services should also take gender- and diversity-medicine aspects into account.

Clinical research is to be organized and implemented within the evolving framework of a structural and faculty-wide department-structure that is to be created interdisciplinary and across hospitals with your participation. A competitive laboratory infrastructure and central animal husbandry will be provided. In addition, there are opportunities for cooperation with 13 neighbouring faculties, or with the Centre for Biotechnology in the use of genomic, post-genomic and bioinformatics methods.

The Medical School OWL is particularly committed to the early promotion of young scientists. To this end, it is expected to support and shape the corresponding curricular structures and to guide and support students in high-quality scientific work up to the structured doctoral degree of Dr. med. At the University Hospital, an active and formative role in the implementation of the "clinician" and "advanced clinician scientist" programs expected.

The course takes place in close cooperation with specialist clinics of various hospital operators in the region Eastern Westphalia Lippe (OWL) as well as with a network of general practitioners. University Hospital OWL of Bielefeld University was founded with Protestant Hospital Bethel (EvKB), Evangelisches Klinikum Bethel, Klinikum Bielefeld and Klinikum Lippe.

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The call is aimed at nationally and internationally renowned personalities who are able to represent the field of dermatology and venerology in research, teaching and patient care in its entirety. Prerequisites are many years of broad clinical experience, high-ranking scientific achievements in immunology/allergy and dermatological oncology, which are reflected in corresponding publications and third-party funding, as well as the specialist recognition in dermatology and venerology.

As the holder of the position, you will head the Department of Dermatology and Venerology at Klinikum Bielefeld. You will further develop the existing focal points of clinical care – inflammatory skin diseases, infectious skin diseases, autoimmune diseases and allergies of the skin and mucous membranes and dermato-oncology with dermatosurgery – at Bielefeld Campus and integrate them into the existing clinical concept in the sense of functional interaction. Likewise, the willingness to participate in the development of the medical research profile as described above is expected. The willingness to cooperate intensively with dermatologists in private practice is assumed. The development of a Comprehensive Cancer Center of the University Hospital OWL is to be supported by the future jobholder. In this respect, the certification as skin tumor center is to be strived for.

The process of building up the Medical School OWL at the Bielefeld location offers a great deal of creative freedom and is associated with many different challenges. We would like to offer this professorship to people who will creatively and ambitiously help shape this development in research and teaching. In addition, committed involvement in the academic self-administration of the university is part of the job profile. The teaching load is basically 4 LVS according to § 5 Abs. 3 LVV from the beginning of the study program. The requirements for employment are in accordance with § 36 HG: A doctorate in human medicine and additional scientific achievements are required to qualify for the W3 professorship.

It is expected that there will be networking with other hospitals of the University Hospital OWL, other faculties of Bielefeld University as well as with the resident medical community in the region. In accordance with these tasks, we are looking for leaders with proven leadership experience and expertise in the above-mentioned fields as well as excellent communication and coordination skills.

The tasks connected with the professorship in the context of health care, including the right to liquidation, are regulated by a contract with the respective hospital. An employment relationship under private law with the university is envisaged for the performance of the tasks of the professorship.
