

This workshop explores the growing influence of artificial intelligence on how we think, search for information, and decide what to believe.

Participants will examine how tools like ChatGPT and other AI systems shape trust, often replacing traditional search engines and becoming sources we rely on, sometimes too quickly.

Through discussions and hands-on activities, we will ask:

- Why do we tend to trust AI responses?
- How does AI affect our ability to think critically?
- What's the difference between searching, thinking, and simply accepting?

We will also explore how AI can be both a source of disinformation and a tool to fight it.
