How to be Culturally Literate in Academia

How to BA (2022 FsBs)

Come join Brian to look at the individual programs of the BA in British and American Studies. Here you will have the opportunity to get information and ask questions about which courses, modules and exams you need to finish your bachelor program. Students in semester 2+ are also welcome!

How to History Module (PM4/PM2)

How To Get Help with the Writing Process on Campus with Ellipsis

The Ellipsis English Writing Centre is a free service offered by the Bielefeld University Fachsprachenzentrum (Language Centre) that offers supplemental help with all aspects of academic writing in English. This short workshop will touch on some of the differences between English and German academic writing, as well as present some of the ways that Ellipsis can help..

How to LPT

With your input, we'll consider how to prepare for the LPT, go through the Grammar & Usage part of the most recent LPT, discuss how to recognise what language structures are being tested (and common pitfalls), and think about strategies for writing the summary.

How to Write Theses and Papers in Linguistics - and what to write about

We'll consider how to approach term papers and theses in linguistics, and what sorts of topics to choose.

How to English Drama Group
