PREAMBLE

LICENSOR has developed and maintains a valuable research dataset known as CHILL, containing preprocessed facial video frames and corresponding raw heart rate labels intended for research on remote Photoplethysmography (rPPG) and heart rate estimation. LICENSEE, an academic institution, desires to obtain access to said dataset for its legitimate non-commercial academic research purposes. Both parties wish to establish clear terms governing the access to, the use, and protection of this valuable research resource.

In consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

GRANT OF LICENSE

LICENSOR hereby grants to LICENSEE as an academic institution a limited, royalty-free, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to access and use the dataset solely for non-commercial academic research and

educational purposes as specified below as RESEARCH PROJECT. This license is personal to the LICENSEE and may not be assigned, sublicensed, or transferred without the express prior written consent of LICENSOR. Any changes to the RESEARCH PROJECT, including the research questions, must be notified to the LICENSOR without delay and require the prior written consent of the LICENSOR.

The LICENSEE acknowledges that this Agreement must be executed by an authorized signatory, who shall assume full responsibility for compliance with all terms and conditions herein. Upon approval, access credentials will be provided exclusively to the PRINCIPAL RESEARCHER's and further LICENSEE RESEARCHERS' e-mail address as specified in below.

PERMITTED AND PROHIBITED USES

Academic Use Only. The dataset may be used exclusively for non-commercial academic research, educational instruction, and scholarly publication as specified below as RESEARCH PROJECT. LICENSEE may incorporate the dataset into research projects, dissertations, academic papers, and educational materials provided such use complies with all terms of this agreement.

Ban on Deanonymization. LICENSEE undertakes to refrain from any action that is intended to lead to the re-identification of study participants (in terms of data protection law: data subjects) or to de-anonymise the anonymised individual statistical data contained in the data, for example by adding corresponding additional information. If, despite the existing assumption that de-anonymisation of the data provided is not possible in the present form, anonymised individual statistical data is de-anonymised by the data recipient in the course of using the data, even if this is not done purposefully, the data recipient must keep this individual statistical data secret and inform the data providers immediately and without delay of the possibility of de-anonymisation and the circumstances thereof.

Commercial Restrictions. LICENSEE expressly agrees that the dataset shall not be used, directly or indirectly, for any commercial purpose. Prohibited uses include, without limitation: development or testing of commercial products or services; creation of commercial datasets or derivative works; military or surveillance applications; governmental systems deployed in public spaces; or any activity intended to generate revenue or commercial advantage.

Distribution Limitations. LICENSEE shall not distribute, share, or provide access to the dataset or any portion thereof to third parties. Limited excerpts may be included in academic publications or presentations solely for illustrative purposes, provided proper attribution is maintained and such use does not compromise the dataset's integrity or LICENSOR's rights.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND ATTRIBUTION

All rights, title, and interest in the dataset remain exclusively with LICENSOR. This Agreement conveys only the limited usage rights explicitly described herein and does not transfer any ownership interest or intellectual property rights to LICENSEE.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Governing Law. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Germany, without regard to conflict of law principles. Any disputes arising hereunder shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Bielefeld.

Entire Agreement. This document constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, or agreements relating to the subject matter hereof. No modification shall be effective unless in writing and signed by both parties. In the event of differences of opinion regarding the scope and content of the license granted by this Agreement, the LICENSOR shall decide.

Severability. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
