

Three student assistants (9h per week) for research project on political discourse and large language models

The Knowledge Representation and Machine Learning Group at Bielefeld University is looking for two student assistants to support research activities in the interdisciplinary “SAIL” (<http://sail.nrw>) subproject “Understanding the Limitations of Large Language Models”. Through a collaboration between computer science and sociology, we investigate the limitations of large language models such as BERT or ChatGPT in settings where there are multiple speakers with various stances that may change during interaction.



You will support us in the annotation of parliamentary debates in German and English parliamentary data and in the analysis of errors that our machine learning models make.

We are looking for candidates that are enrolled at a German university, possess good German and English reading proficiency, and, ideally but not necessarily have a background in the social sciences.

Minimum contract duration is 3 months with an option to renew the contract afterwards. The start date is as soon as possible.
