Universität Bielefeld

Bielefeld University in numbers.

Internationally recognized for its top-level research and innovative teaching, Bielefeld University makes a significant contribution to a progressive and participatory knowledgebased society. It is an attractive, family-friendly place to work and study, and is characterised by a culture of open communication, lived interdisciplinarity, diversity, and freedom for personal development.

Bielefeld University was **founded in 1969** with an explicit mission to conduct leading-edge research and to provide high-quality teaching based on this research. Today, the university serves approximately **25,000 students** and includes **14 faculties** – ranging from the humanities, natural sciences, and social sciences to technology and medicine.

How to reach Bielefeld

Düsseldorf

(approx. 190 km from Bielefeld)

From Düsseldorf airport, the Skytrain will take you to the train station in about 5 minutes. Depending on which train you take (direct or with a change in Hamm or Duisburg), the journey takes 2 hours.

Frankfurt am Main

(approx. 320 km from Bielefeld) There are Intercity connections from <u>Frankfurt</u> <u>Airport</u> to Bielefeld (departure every hour with change in Cologne or Hanover - journey time approx. 4 hours).

Hanover

(about 110 km to Bielefeld)

The S-Bahn line S5 takes you from <u>Hanover</u> <u>Airport</u> to the main railway station in Hanover city centre in 12 minutes.

Intercity trains from Hanover to Bielefeld run every hour. Travel time approx. 50-60 minutes (without changing trains).

Cologne-Bonn

(about 200 km to Bielefeld) Intercity trains run every hour from <u>Cologne-</u> <u>Bonn Airport</u> to Bielefeld, approximate travel time 3 hours.

Dortmund

(about 110 km to Bielefeld) You can either take a free shuttle bus from <u>Dortmund Airport</u> to Holzwickede, and from there a regional train to Bielefeld, changing in Hamm (time about 1 hour) or take a shuttle bus to Dortmund Main Station (project duration: 25 minutes) and from there a through train to Bielefeld (travel time: less than an hour).

Tip: Germany uses type C and F sockets (230V). Make sure your devices are compatible or bring an adapter!



Transportation

The local public transportation provider is called **"moBiel**," which operates an extensive network of bus and tram lines throughout the city and surrounding areas. The city is also connected to regional and national train networks, with the **Bielefeld Hauptbahnhof (central station)** serving as a major transportation hub.

Tickets can be purchased at ticket machines located at bus and train stops, as well as at many convenience stores and kiosks throughout the city. There are also various types of tickets available, including single ride tickets, day passes, and monthly passes, depending on your needs.

Deutschland Ticket

With the Deutschland-Ticket (D-Ticket) you can now travel comfortably on all public transport for just €58 per month.

This ticket is a subscription. It must be cancelled before the 10th of each month.



How to arrive?

from Bielefeld Central Station (Bielefeld Hauptbahnhof), take the S-Bahn 4 direction "Lohmannshof" and get off at "Universität" station. The journey takes approximately 15 minutes. Alternatively, you can walk to the university from the city centre in about 30 -40 minutes or in 15 minutes with "Mein Siggi" bike.
