## Long-distance object agreement in Basque and Hungarian

The paper highlights parallels between long distance person and number agreement in Basque nominalized complement clauses and Hungarian definiteness agreement patterns in infinitival clauses. Both languages provide evidence for the mediator role of the clause in establishing long-distance object agreement. Besides the similarities, different morphosyntactic mechanisms are discussed to account for the agreement patterns involving participant arguments.
